#### ART SHOW UPDATE

The Motor Mill art show on Saturday, Sept. 30 was a big success. There were nearly 300 people and \$561.00 in sales and donations. The car counter recorded 220 vehicles. At least 7 artist were on site selling and several more were brought by Bent Willow Gallery for sale. A large number of people donated personal art from family collections for display. 7 artists were creating art on site during the show. Event banners and drink dispensers were purchased with the Thrivant grant that can be used for a variety of events.

Jane sent thank-you's to sponsors. Ideas for improvements were discussed.

#### **ELECTION OF DIRECTORS – 3-YEAR TERMS**

Morine moved to nominate Les Klink to serve another 3-year term on the Motor Mill Foundation board of directors. Lee seconded. There were no other nominations. Carried.

#### **ELECTION OF OFFICERS – 1-YEAR TERMS**

Lenth moved that the current slate of officers – president, John Nikolai; vice-president, John deNeui; secretary, Larry Stone; and treasurer, Chuck Morine – be elected for another year. Morine seconded. There were no other nominations. Carried

PROTOCOL FOR CHARGES AND PAYING OF BILLS

Morine recommended to keep the current system for paying bills in place to maintain flexibility and not slow down bill payment.

#### DATES FOR 2018 AND INTERNSHIPS

The mill will be open every weekend from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Dates will be submitted for Clayton County Event calendar.

The board recommended we have one full time intern and one part time intern if we are to be open every weekend again. Staffing became very difficult and some foundation members were overburdened filling in for members not able to cover their shift due to illness and other reasons. In the past volunteers worked 4-6 dates per season. Some members worked 15 or more dates this season.

Foundation members were asked to send a list of intern projects to Jenna by first of December to justify 2 interns.

Metcalf suggested that the foundation and interns come up with regular events at the mill to boost visitation like monthly savanna hikes and another Stem event

Get the word out. Nikolai suggested he and others could find people to work the desk more easily than new tour guides.
